Kiwanis Club of Galena Helps Build the Galena ARC Art Department Scholarship Fund

Galena, IL—The Galena ARC Art Department would like to thank the Kiwanis Club of Galena for their generous support of our youth art program. They donated \$100 to help build the scholarship fund to ensure all Jo Daviess County youth have an opportunity to participate in art classes.

Youth art classes are offered throughout the year for ages 6-14. A variety of classes are offered, such as: painting, drawing, sculpture, wood burning, collage, mosaics, fabric dyeing, paper making, and sewing classes. New this Fall is a Galena Schools SIP Day art class (Friday, November 6). The brown bus can transport the students to the Galena ARC at 11:30 am. Students will bring a sack lunch to eat before they begin the Stacking Blocks art class. Students will choose a theme for their stacking blocks and paint all four sides a different character. Finished blocks can then be rotated and stacked to make an all new character. Class concludes at 5 pm but students can stay until 5:30 pm to accommodate family schedules.

Art classes are also offered to the Galena ARC preschool classes and summer camp kids. Classes are developed so that all age groups and artistic levels can have a successful outcome.
